

Browsing/Print Journal Collection Policy

April 4, 2018

The mission of the browsing/print journal collection encompasses the purposes below. Decisions about purchases and cancellations will be guided by those considerations.

1. Provide access to print periodicals that support major assignments in the core or departmental curricula and are otherwise unavailable in online format.
2. Support lifelong learning, especially using the collection for instruction purposes to build awareness of major publications in Salve Regina's fields of study.
- ~~3.~~ Enhance library spaces with opportunities for pleasure reading, thereby providing the Salve Regina community with the opportunity to browse popular publications.
4. Support the curriculum with access to print periodicals to which we do not provide current online access (including embargoed periodicals for which up-to-date access is essential).
5. Provide access to print periodicals that reflect the mission, culture, and activities of the Sisters of Mercy, and to continually educate our community and visitors about the university mission.
6. Provide access to print periodicals that provide opportunities for our community to be informed about local news and history.
