


Accessing Course Reserves

2. By default, the **All Courses** tab will be selected, and all courses on reserve will be visible. Courses on reserve can also be viewed by **instructor** or by **subject** (eg. English, Biology, etc.).
Scroll to your course, or search for your course by **course number** (eg. GST450 or GST 450), **course name** (eg. Capstone), or **instructor's last name**. Click **Go** and select your course from your search results.
